

Clydebank Museum and the Govan Stones

Wednesday 19th February 2020

Join us for a guided tour of the **Clydebank Museum and Art Gallery**, located in the former Clydebank Town Hall and situated beside the shipyard where many of the famous liners of the Clyde were built.

The Museum features permanent exhibitions concentrating on Clydebank's proud industrial heritage (Singer Sewing Machine Factory and the Shipbuilding Industry) alongside temporary galleries for exciting touring exhibitions, as well as the Council's permanent exhibition of fine art, featuring works by contemporary Scottish artists.

In the afternoon, we will visit the **Govan Stones at Govan Old Church**, a unique collection of early medieval stones carved in the 9th – 11th centuries to commemorate the power of those who ruled the Kingdom of Strathclyde.

Explore 31 monuments dating from this period, including beautifully carved crosses and cross shafts, and five magnificent hogback stones. Enjoy the intricate interlace carving and warrior figures on the collection's outstanding piece – the Govan Sarcophagus, the only one of its kind carved from solid stone from pre-Norman, northern Britain.

The cost of this outing covers coach travel, gratuities, a soup and sandwich lunch at the Museum and tea & coffee at Govan Old Church.

Our coach will depart from the Graham Hills Building at 10.30am and we will aim to be back in Glasgow City Centre by approximately 3.45pm.
